

## Pentecost

is a Christian holiday which takes place on the 50th day after Easter Sunday. It commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon Mary, mother of Jesus and the Apostles of Jesus while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks, as described in the Acts of the Apostles.

It's May. Jesus is still risen and we continue to celebrate Easter. The lilacs are blooming. The grass is growing, the trees are budding and things are looking good. This is an amazing month to see God's goodness in creation.

This is also an amazing month to see God's goodness in worship as we come together. As I said, we continue celebrating Easter. The resurrection of Jesus is the most important, most influential event in all history. The world thought that they had silenced this one who remembered the forgotten, who searched for the lost, who healed the weak and ill, who cast out demons and stood for all the ones those in charge want us to cast out. Jesus made them all look ineffective, or mean, or callous, or unconcerned and they wanted to silence him and keep him silent. Crucifixion typically did that but this time it was not enough. The love of God defeats the suffering; it defeats the abandonment and the death. Jesus rises again and death is defeated. That is worth celebrating and we continue our alleluias this month.

We also celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit and the birth of the Church. At the Ascension, Jesus asks the disciple to remain because the Holy Spirit is to be given them. With a rush of wind, a loud noise, and tongues of fire the Spirit descends giving the disciples, and through them even us, the inspiration, the strength, the stamina to share God's love with all. We proclaim God's love through the presence of the Spirit in our lives and we use words when we have to.

At the end of May, when we celebrate with graduates we also pause to remember God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Moving into the world we have the grace of God Father as creation gives us strength. We have the forgiveness of the Son, Jesus Christ, God's Word made flesh who grants us new life to try again. We have the presence of the Holy Spirit leading us, guiding us, and guarding us as we move into the struggles of everyday life bringing love and peace, mercy and hope.

It's really spring when May arrives. The world awakens and we find delight. May we also find delight in the presence of the risen Christ, in the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives and the goodness of the Trinity to inspire us. It's May and may we all lives as God's children.

### St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church

Date: April 8, 2024

CALL TO ORDER: President, Kaleb Headings
OPENING DEVOTIONS: Pastor Steve Edmiston

### AGENDA REVIEW:

Kaleb motioned to add AED training and donation choice of special offerings from Lenten, Palm Sunday and Easter services to Old Business. Pastor Steve seconded the motion and motion passed.

Myron moved to add sell / donation of the bus to New Business. Wes seconded the motion and motion passed.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

The bus continues to cost the church and has bending expenses. Myron has spoken with the minister of the Lima Baptist Church who suggested that they could use the bus is St John's was willing to donate it. The bus operation remains problematic. The Property committee has been unable to get a clear Kelley Blue Book value due to variables and current problems. Myron suggested that the church should donated it while it still can be driven away. Myron motioned to donate the bus to Lima Baptist Church and Ann seconded the motion. Motion passed.

- AED training Kaleb spoke to Sidney Fire Chief. A free training (not CPR) to be scheduled out several months so that there is sufficient time to announce in bulletin and newsletter. He to suggested a training session to help make individuals feel comfortable but urged the church to avoid not using the AED in an emergency until the training can be done.

It was unclear what the relationship is between MRM and Just Breath Health and Wellness. Kaleb will get more details this.
  Becky suggested that the donations be given to Indian Lake to support their recovery from the tornado. Pastor Steve pointed out that Luther's Purse is contributing to this.
